The International Roundtable on "Stakeholder / Public Participation for the Integrated Management of Shared Water Resources - The Case of Nestos / Mesta River Basin", held from 15-16 April 2008, in Sofia, Bulgaria, and organised by the Global Water Partnership - Mediterranean and the Global Water Partnership – Bulgaria was attended by INWEB Secretary General Mr. Charalampos Skoulidakis.
