A North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Advanced Research Workshop (ARW) entitled “Effect of Climate Change on Water Supplies-Issues of National and Global Security” will be held from 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> September 2010 in Izmir, Turkey.

The purpose of this ARW is to provide a valuable opportunity for scientists in key related fields to establish strategies and priorities for much needed interdisciplinary work on the response of surface and subsurface water resources to climate change related phenomena. In this regard, groundwater, climate change and security are now considered to form a common interface between scientists, engineers, economists and politicians. It is expected that 50 scientists from about 35 countries will attend the workshop, which will include both platform and poster sessions. UNESCO Chair INWEB coordinator Prof. J.Ganoulis will be a key speaker at this event.
