The main objectives of the workshop are to conduct a critical review of the current technical and scientific status of non-chemical environmental stressors, to evaluate the potential application of current chemical risk analysis approaches to non-chemical stressors and to provide a comprehensive analysis of management alternatives. Within this larger context, systematic strategies for investigating and addressing uncertainty and its effect on modeling results and policy recommendations will be given particular priority.
